Esmer House is a **Prader-Willi syndrome** residential care home, providing support to meet the needs of people living with the condition.

The specialist home has **six bedrooms across two floors** and 24-hour support. Residents can enjoy the large lounge and dining areas, as well as a spacious back garden.

Esmer House is located in a residential area. It is in short walking distance from a **leisure centre** where residents can take part in fitness classes, badminton, tennis and more.

Residents can also take advantage of nearby Sherwood Forest and **amenities in Mansfield**, such as a cinema, trampoline centre and snooker hall. Visiting the town of Mansfield is just a 15 minute bus journey away.

Although there is no cure for Prader-Willi syndrome, our goal is to help the people we support to lead **healthy, fulfilling lives** with care from a team who understand their condition.

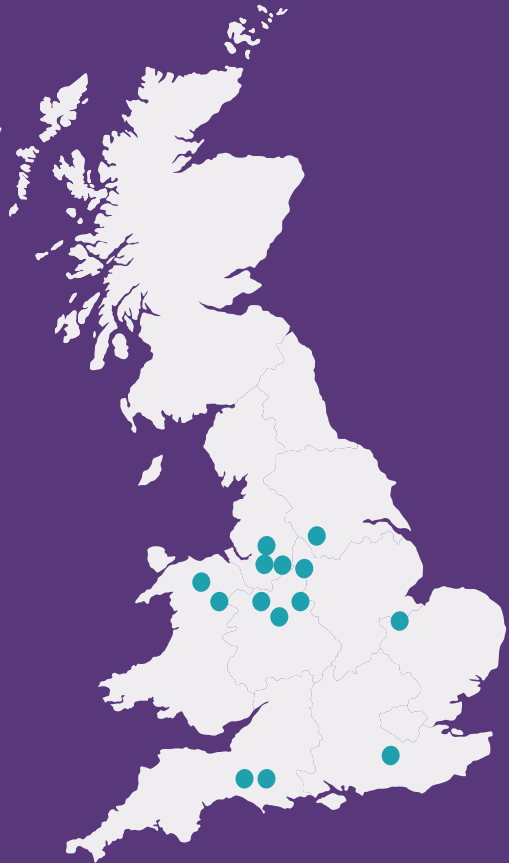
