With lots of space, we have an ample-sized dining area and a lounge with comfy sofas - perfect for cozy chats, stories or watching TV and films. We also have a relaxing sensory area with bubble tubes, mirrors, fiber optic lights and a water bed.

Located next to a local farm, there are lovely views from the property across the countryside. Bramley Avenue is also within walking distance of local shops and a short drive away from the centre of Cambridge and Royston. Melbourn itself is an idyllic, quiet village with a church, train station, food shops, chip shop and a local Eco Hub & café.

Our two onsite adapted minibuses enable us to take lots of day trips and be a part of the local community. As an active group, we love being involved in outdoor activites such as swimming at the Windmill hydrotherapy pool, going to the cinema, bowling, visiting country parks and so much more!
