New Fern is our residential transition care home in West Yorkshire. Here, we support up to four individuals aged between 16-25 with learning disabilities, autism and complex needs.

It is a purpose-built service across three floors. Along with generous sized bedrooms, there are lots of communal spaces to relax and socialise. This includes the modern kitchen, lounge with dining area, private outdoor area and a sensory room complete with a whirlpool bath!

Located in Ovenden, New Fern is surrounded by large playing fields and is just a short walk away from the local shops, takeaways, pubs, churches and hairdressers. The town of Halifax can be reached in under ten minutes by excellent transport links for educational and volunteer opportunities. We also have service vehicles available for day trips to the local countryside

## Our vacancies

We currently have a number of vacancies at New Fern across the first floor. These large rooms all have a built-in wardrobe and an en-suite with a shower.

New Fern is ideal for an individual who is progressing from a child service to an adults service. This service is based on the NHS pathway model, which means that we can support the individual to continue their education while learning independent living skills. Our experienced behavioural support team will work in partnership with the individual, their family and support team to provide a route of progression, which can include progression from a residential living service to their own supported living property in the future.

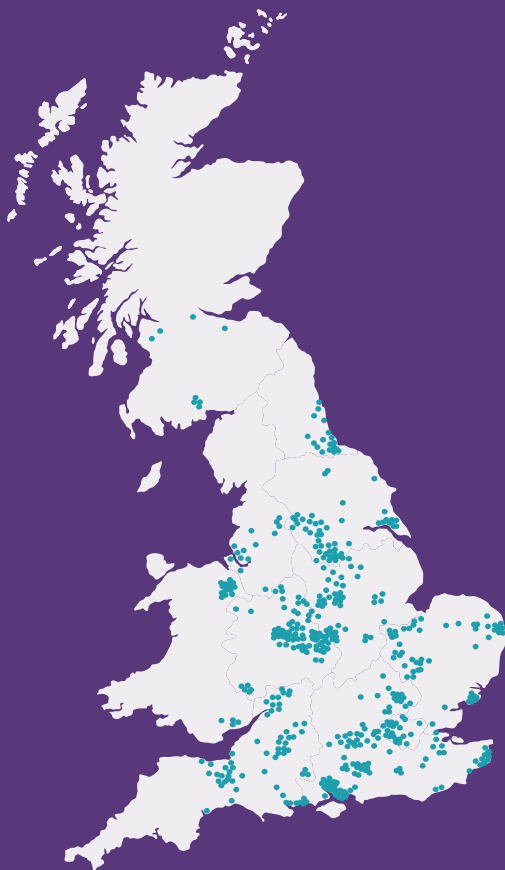
