66 Dudley Street is a residential care home for up to six adults with learning disabilities, autism, challenging behaviour and complex needs. The home was purpose built to meet the needs of autistic people, with wide corridors and low stimulus decor.

We have a number of spacious shared areas, including our large communal lounge. This lounge leads out into the beautiful back garden where residents help with gardening by planting herbs, seasonal flowers and making garden boxes. There is also plenty of fun to be had on the garden swing! The dining room leads into the TV area, which is our favourite spot to get cosy and watch a movie.

We have fantastic transport links to Birmingham and West Bromwich. Our property is just a two minute walk away from the gym, local cafes and cinema. As well as being close to public transport, we have two service vehicles which allow us to make trips further afield.

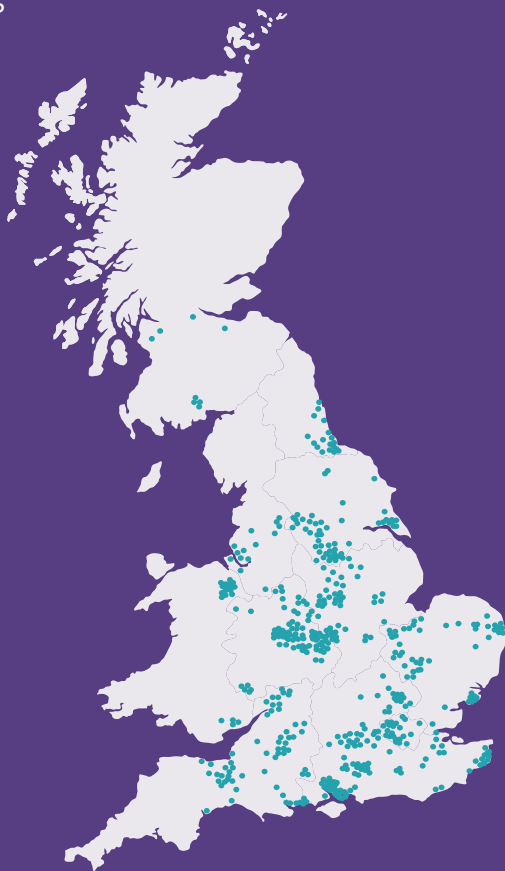
