Chiltern View

Chiltern View is a residential home that supports individuals with autism, challenging behaviour, epilepsy, learning disabilities, mental health and physical disabilities.

The large, modern and spacious bungalow is in a quiet location and is equipped with a sensory / activity room. Some rooms have an en-suite and there are two wet rooms, one which houses a bath. The service is fully accessible for wheelchairs.

Chiltern View is just 10 minutes drive away from the bustling town centre of Aylesbury. The town offers both history and heritage of it's old quarter as well as the modern shopping centres and nightlife of a contemporary town.

Nearby is Quainton Windmill and Dunstable Downs, perfect for walks and picnics.

Due to the location of the property, public transport is limited.





The vacancy

We currently have two vacancies at Chiltern View. Both rooms are on the ground floor. One of the rooms has an en-suite and faces the front garden whereas the other looks out on to a field where residents can see sheep and goats.

Both of the rooms have profiling beds and their own basin. One of the rooms has a ceiling hoist to assist anyone with restricted mobility.

The residents at Chiltern View enjoy a variety of activities in the home and out in the community. We do arts and crafts, karaoke and baking sessions.

The service has access to specialist additional services such as PBS, clinical and support with nutrition. The GP surgery is just 560 yards away.
