There are also regular buses to Aldershot and Petersfield for day trips. Portsmouth is just half an hour away by car, with a harbour and beaches that are easily accessible and has great fish and chip shops!



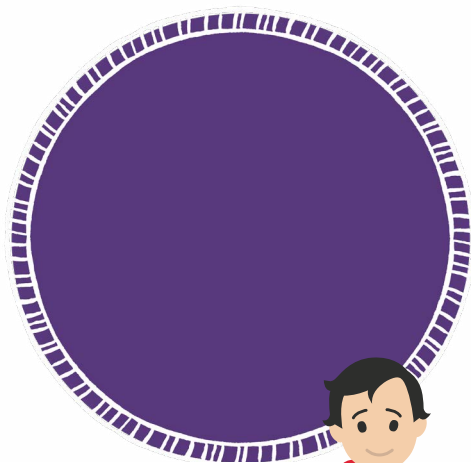


The vacancy

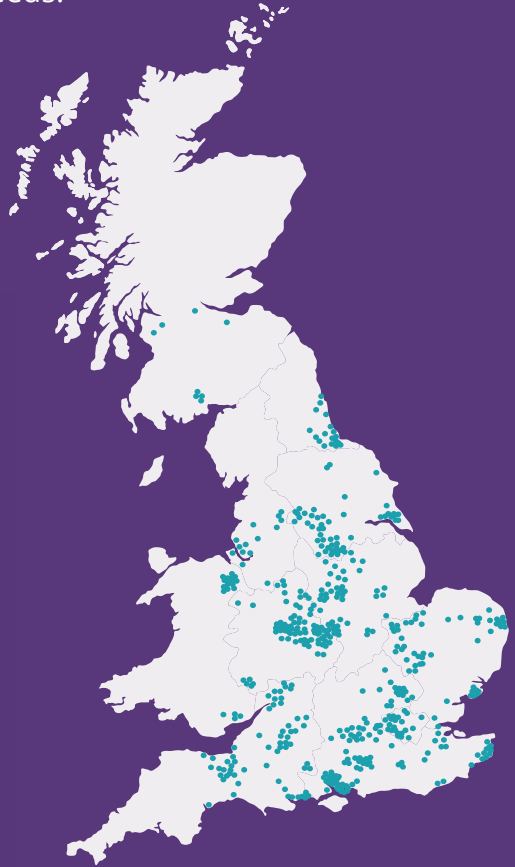
