A place to call home

Brookfields is a nursing care home, supporting up to six people with learning and physical disabilities. The home provide 24 hour nursing support, which includes catheter care and care for people with epilespy, diabetes and other complex care needs.

The six bedroom home is fully accessible for wheelchair users and all bedrooms are on the ground floor. The service has a communal lounge with a large TV and plenty of space for residents to socialise. The home has an adapted bathroom and wet room, with overhead tracking, plus a spacious kitchen and dining area where residents are supported to prepare meals.

Brookfields is located in Oldbury, close to Birmingham city centre. There are a number of local amenities nearby and staff support residents to access community-based activities that meet sensory needs, including hydrotherapy sessions.





We currently have one vacancy. The vacant room is on the ground floor with access to the shared bathroom. We encourage the people we support to decorate their rooms to reflect their individual choices.

The service has a dedicated activity coordinator, ensuring that the people we support continue to develop their own hobbies, skills and interests.

Many of our current residents enjoy baking and often spend time together enjoying their meals in our secluded garden when the weather allows.

Brookfields is a fun and friendly home and our highly skilled team are committed to ensuring that each day has value and purpose for the people we support.
