Located in the sleepy village of Shinfield, **Rookery Cottage is also fairly close to the M4** and Reading town centre. Shinfield itself has shops, cafes, and good public transport. Our residents enjoy going for walks and cycling around the local lake or visiting the farm, which is a short walk away.
