Orchard Leigh is a **residential care home supporting up to eight people** with mild to severe learning disabilities, autism, epilepsy or sensory impairment and mental health support needs.

The home is located in Cheltenham, **situated in a quiet residential area** in the heart of the Cotswold, yet walking distance from all the local amenities.

We have **six large bedrooms with ensuite facilities** and two flats within the main house. There is a **large lounge area**, **kitchen and dining room** with patio doors. This leads onto the decking area and garden where our family of ducks live! This is an extremely social area of our home, particularly in the summer months.





The vacancy

Our first-floor vacancy is a large double room with an ensuite bathroom. This vacancy is ideal for somebody aged 20+ looking to be a part of a sociable home.

Our residents take part in numerous **activities outside of the home** as a group, we have two vehicles for use.

These activities include swimming, attending day centres and work placements, voluntary work, support with home visits, trips to local attractions, such as the Cotswold Wildlife Park, and plenty of shopping trips.
