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126 Castle Lane is a **residential care home**, set in the suburban village of Olton, Solihull. Here, we provide **high-quality support for three individuals** with learning disabilities and acquired brain injuries.

Our home has three bedrooms on the first-floor. Our residents share **communal areas** within the property, including a spacious lounge, kitchen and dining room, where our residents love to engage in meal preparations and playing games such as Connect Four with staff.

The service takes a **person-centred** approach and encourages each individual to live as independently as possible.

Based in Solihull, the service is on a local bus-route towards the town centre and the train station is only a five-minute drive away, making it **ideal for those looking to explore the surrounding area**.

We currently have **one vacant room at our home**, which is on the first-floor. This room has access to two shared shower rooms within the property. All bathrooms have been fitted with grab-bars for additional accessibility needs.

This vacancy would be ideal for an individual aged 40+ who would enjoy living in a **quiet, peaceful environment** and engaging in **on-site activities**. The individual will need to be fully mobile to access the first-floor room using the staircase.

Our residents thoroughly enjoy participating in **a variety of community activities**, as well as visiting the large nearby park and some of the local shops, which are all within walking distance.

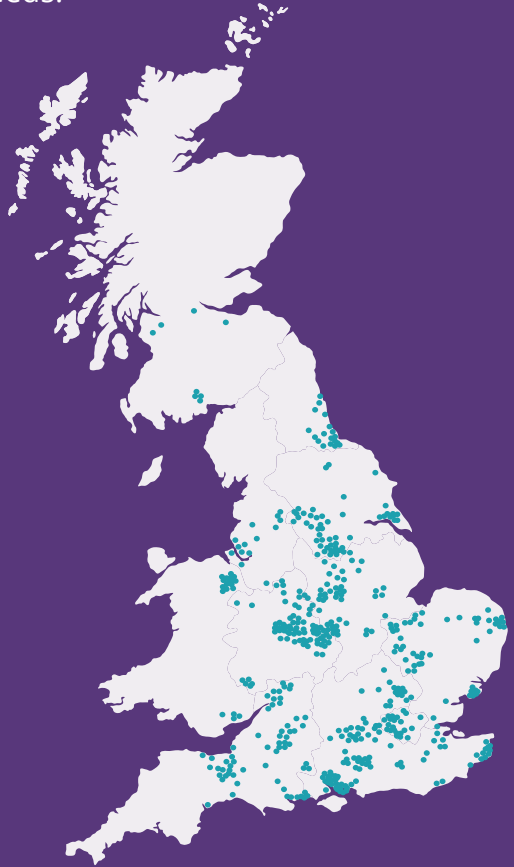
