Our Victorian-built home has six double bedrooms, each with en-suite bathrooms. Our residents share communal areas including two large lounge-diners and a locked kitchen.

There is a **spacious garden** at the back of home with a patio area, where we hold our popular garden parties.

Based in Dronfield, the service is within walking distance of local shops and public transport links. A short walk away, there is the local bus stop and a train station where our residents can travel into Chesterfield or Sheffield, which is **ideal for those considering further education opportunities**.

We currently have **two vacancies at our home**, with a third upcoming in the next few months. Both vacancies are on the first-floor. Those looking to move in will need to be **fully mobile** to access the first-floor rooms using the staircase.
