We support up to **four adults** with learning disabilities, autism, Down's syndrome, and other needs. Our service empowers the people we support to keep active and **achieve their goals**.

We access local day opportunities and other social activities that are part of **co-created support plans**, to help the people we support get the most out of each day!

Our detached home has **four bedrooms** on the first floor, as well as a communal bathroom. A separate toilet is located on the ground floor, along with a cosy lounge, spacious open-plan kitchen diner and a designated laundry area. We also have a **conservatory** that overlooks our garden.

Abbotts Road has **excellent transport links**, and is close to Birmingham and the Star City entertainment complex. Current residents enjoy frequent trips here!





## The vacancy

We currently have one vacancy at Abbots Road. This spacious room is **furnished** and decorated in neutral colours. There is also a convenient wash basin located in this room.

The vacant room is on the first floor, so it is important that our new housemate is **fully mobile**. Abbots Road is currently home to **two males and one female**, all aged between 30-50.

At Abbots Road, we encourage the people we support to decorate their rooms with photographs of friends and family to make them **feel at home**.

The service has a **good choice of activities** for people we support to take part in, either in the house or out in the community.

Residents can choose to make use of **additional one on one hours** to do activities they wish to do and current residents are very happy with the support they receive.

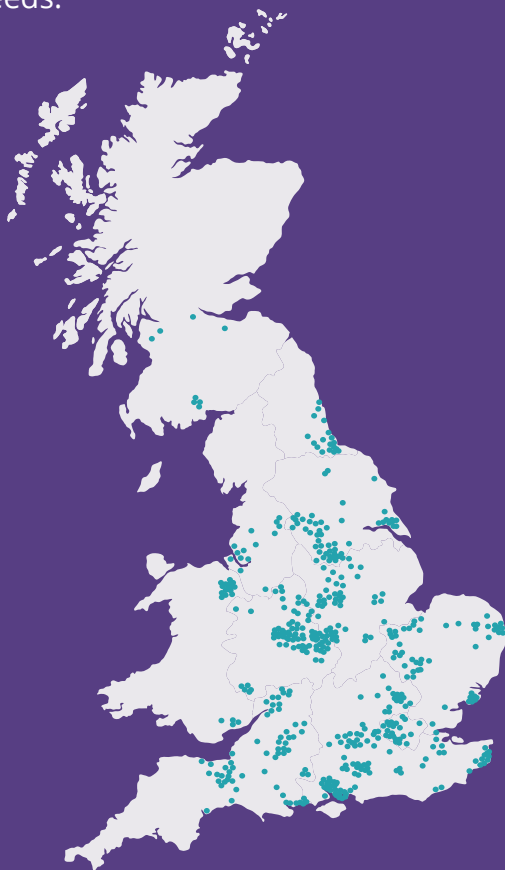
