579 Maidstone Road is a National Autistic Society (NAS) accredited **residential care home**, in Maidstone, Kent. We provide support **for up to six females** with learning disabilities, autism, challenging behaviour and mental health needs.

Our detached home has five bedrooms and there is selfcontained accommodation for one person in a separate building.

Residents share a spacious communal living room and a large kitchen-diner, where people can enjoy meal preparation. We also have an **activities room** for pamper sessions, music time, discos, plus arts and crafts.

The **front and rear gardens** offer space for outdoor gatherings and celebrations or peaceful alone time. We also love a delicious BBQ, come rain or shine.

The service has **excellent public transport links** to the local town centre and Hempsted Valley Shopping Centre. There are also fast trains into London that take less than 45 minutes.

We currently have **one vacancy at our home** on the first floor.

The vacancy is ideal for an individual, aged 18+ who would enjoy living in a **lively home**, where they will be positively supported to learn daily living skills and enjoy meaningful activities.
