The service takes a **person-centred** approach to meeting the wellbeing outcomes of each individual, supporting them to engage in a range of activities, such as arts and crafts, in our upstairs conservatory. We also have pamper sessions and an **onsite sensory and music room** for residents to enjoy.

Based in Somerset, the service is close to both Yeovil and Bath, perfect for those wanting to explore nearby towns and cities.

We currently have **two vacancies at our home**, one of which is on the first floor and the other is ground floor. Both vacancies have en-suite bathrooms. All bathrooms have been fitted with grab-bars for additional accessibility when bathing. The first-floor rooms can be accessed using both the staircase and the lift, for those that need it.

Residents share other communal areas within the property including a spacious lounge, a dining room and a kitchen, where residents cook and learn independent living skills.

These vacancies are perfect for individuals who would enjoy living in a **stimulating**, **supportive** and **caring** environment.
