We currently support people with epilepsy, diabetes, learning disabilities, mental health issues and physical disabilities. Our home boasts a welcoming and friendly home environment, adapted to meet the needs of all the people who live here.

We have **spacious shared areas**, including a dining area, lounge and large kitchen. The lounge leads out onto our garden area, where **we love to plan activities in the summer months**.

All of our bedrooms have **modern furnishings** and we encourage the people we support to decorate their rooms to their own personal style and taste.

Our vacancies are ideal for individuals aged **between 40-60**, with moderate to severe learning disabilities and complex health needs.

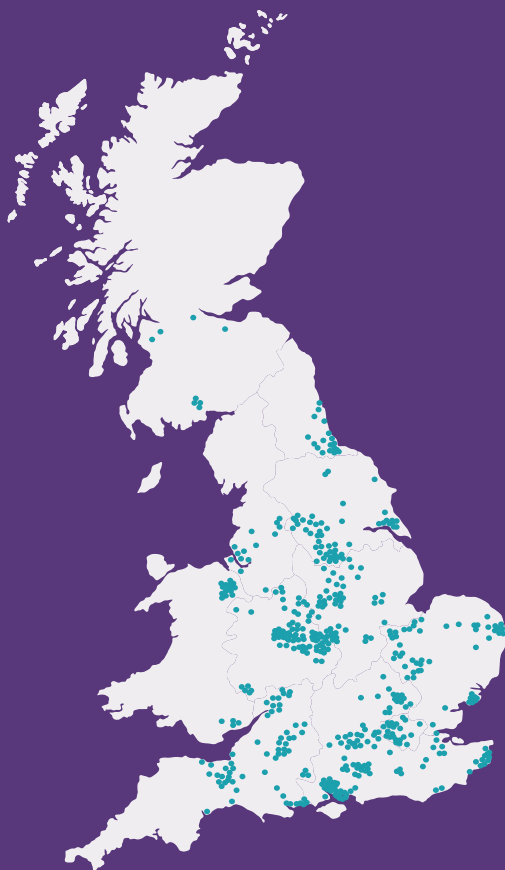
