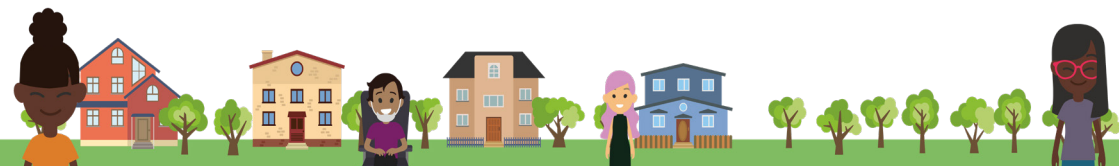


## A place to call home

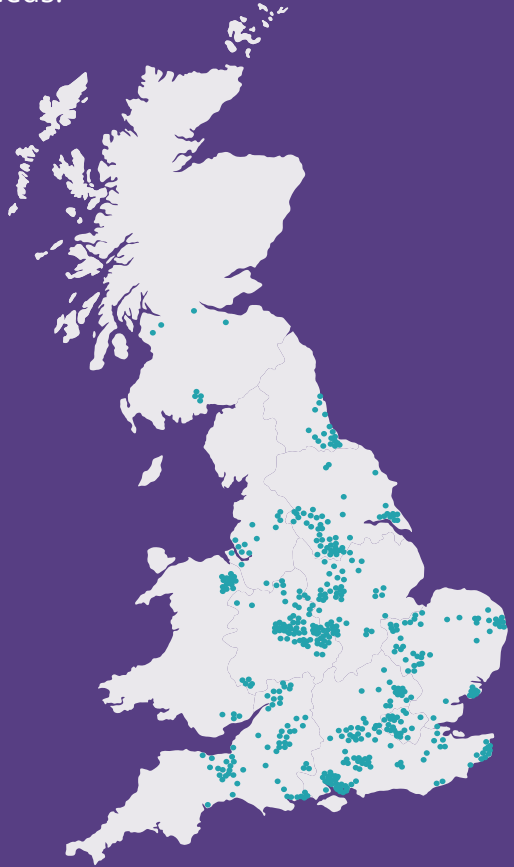
