Cote House is a residential care home in Chippenham, Wiltshire. We provide **24-hour, nurse-led care for 11 people** with brain injury non-rehabilitation, cerebral palsy, challenging behaviour, epilepsy, learning and physical disabilities, and mental health needs.

Our 11 cosy bedrooms are spread across two floors, with the first floor rooms accessible by **lift**. Feeling sociable? 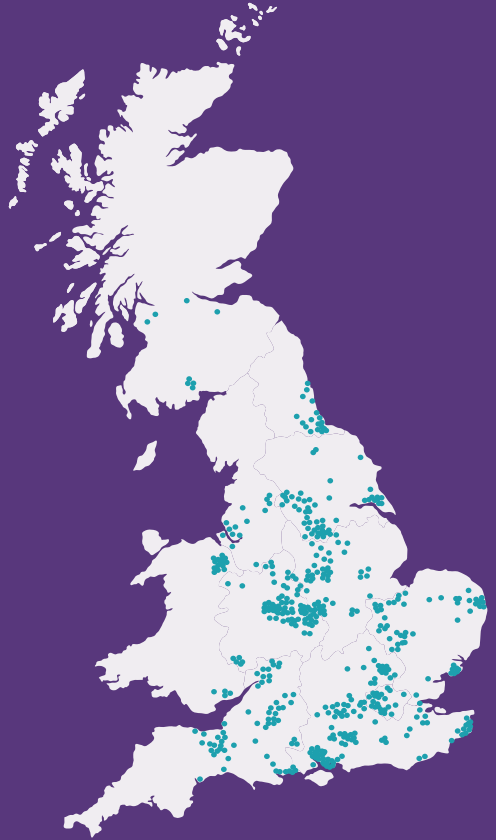
