Located in Chesterfield, Linnet Mews is a specialist residential home offering support for up to **ten adults with complex neurological needs**, including acquired brain injuries, complex / enduring mental health needs, behaviours of concern, complex traumatic histories, neurodegenerative conditions and Functional Neurological Disorder.

Our purpose-built home has **six accessible en-suite bedrooms** for full residential care, and **four fully furnished, self-contained flats** for those ready to embrace more independence.

We have plenty of space for **developing important skills**, including:

- ✓ **dedicated therapy quarter** on the first floor, accessible via a lift
- ✓ **accessible outdoor areas**, including a landscaped rear garden
- ✓ **multi-functional gym** to support physical rehabilitation

As part of our approach, we deliver **holistic, active support**. Promoting a functional approach, we focus on **developing skills in everyday scenarios**.

Where appropriate for your needs, we **engage you with the community** as an extended provision for support - improving relationships, establishing opportunities, and increasing awareness of behaviours in social environments.
