If you have sensory needs, or just want a space to relax, we've got a **sensory room** kitted out with fibre optic lights, a ball pool and other sensory equipment. Our sensory room is also fitted with tracking hoists.

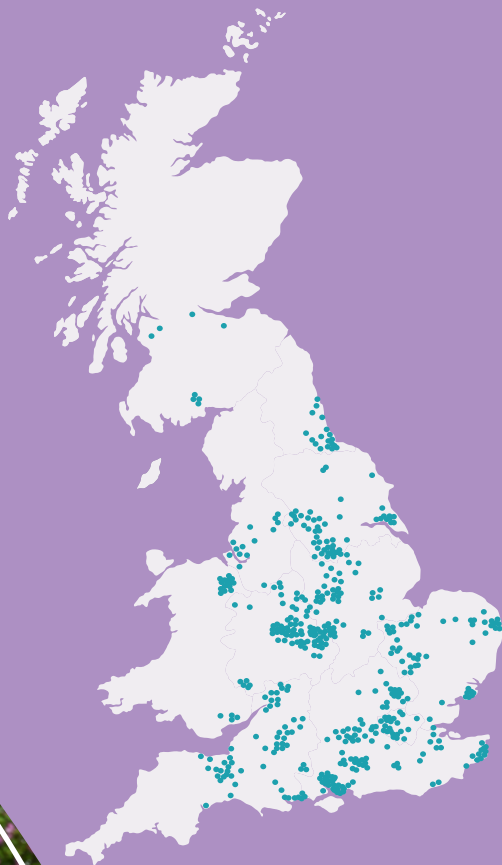
