Our traditional country farmhouse is set in peaceful, private grounds, featuring an enchanting walled garden and extensive lawned areas. We have **31 bedrooms** comprising three en-suite rooms, five rooms with private toilets and wash areas, and 22 rooms with access to shared bathrooms.

We also benefit from a **self-contained apartment**, which is accessible via steps - ideal for someone who has good mobility and can live with more independence. Designed with **independence at heart**, our unique apartment is complete with kitchen facilities, a living/dining area and a bedroom with an en-suite wet room.

Wey House is specially adapted to **provide high-quality care** in a welcoming, community setting. Our fully qualified nursing team, guided by our Clinical Lead, support housemates with dual or multiple needs and are trained to respond to each person's changing requirements, **helping everyone feel safe, supported, and confident.**

We support a wide range of needs, including:

-  Neurological, mental health, and behavioural needs – progressive conditions, acquired brain injuries, personality disorders, and complex mental health conditions
-  Learning and developmental needs – learning disabilities and autism
-  Physical and medical needs – cardiovascular conditions, diabetes, bariatric care, and dysphagia
-  End-of-life care – compassionate palliative support

Our specialist clinical care includes:

-  PEG feeding, catheter, and stoma care
-  Dressings, pressure care, and wound management
-  Oxygen therapy, suction procedures, and tracheostomy care
-  Medication administration


