They have been built and furnished to a high standard, incorporating durable, tamper-resistant fixtures and fittings, while still creating a warm, homely environment.

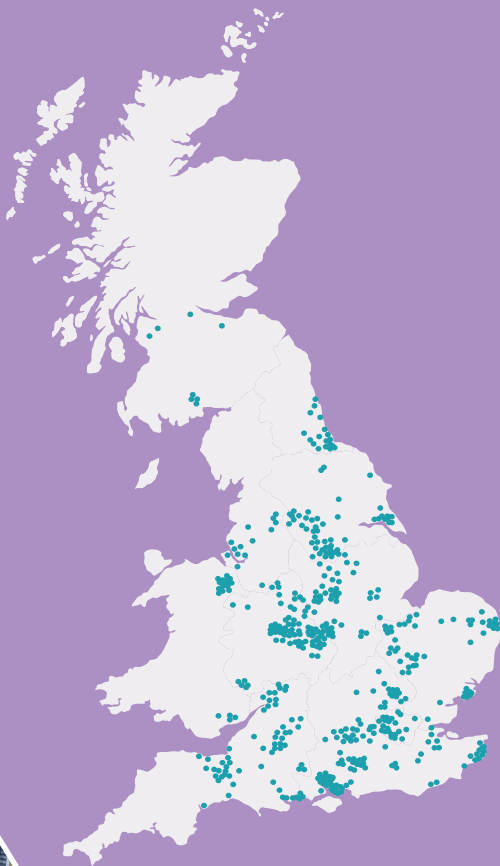
